- 2. I will not ask for personal information from the newcomers, except as part of the necessary information-gathering required by this effort.
- 3. Any personal information that is shared with me will be kept confidential with the following exceptions:
  - The newcomer asks me to convey the information to someone who can provide support (e.g., doctor, counselor, etc.)
  - Providing information to the organizers of this effort on a need-to-know basis
  - There is an urgent situation which I feel requires disclosure: this disclosure will be made to the organizers of this effort
  - I hear something (e.g., a traumatic event is described to me) that I feel I need further support with: I will debrief with the organizers of this effort
  - I will not record or write about any experiences of the newcomers should they choose to share any with me except in the circumstances described above
- 4. I will not take any photos or videos of the newcomers, or involve or post pictures of the newcomers in any kind of social media. (Facebook, Snapchat, Instagram, Twitter, etc.)
- 5. I will not ask newcomers if I can take photos or videos of them.
