وبِصَوْمِ غَلِ نُويْتُ مِنْ شَهْرِ مَمَضَانَ

I intend to keep the fast for tomorrow in the month of Ramadan

Dua for breaking fast

اللَّهُمِّ إِنِّى لَكَ صُمْتُ وَبِلَكَ امْنُتُ وَعَلَيْكَ تَوكُّلكُ وَعَلَى بِرزُقِكَ أَفْطَرُتُ

O Allah! I fasted for You and I believe in You and I put my trust in You and I break my fast with Your sustenance.

يَاأَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا كُتِبَ عَلَيْكُمُ الصِّيامُ كَمَا كُتِبَ عَلَى الَّذِينَ مِنْ قَبُلِكُمْ لَعَلَّكُمْ تَتَّقُونَ

O you who have believed, decreed upon you is fasting as it was decreed upon those before you that you may become righteous

Narrated Ibn 'Abbas (may Allah be pleased with him): The Prophet (sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam) was the most generous amongst the people, and he used to be more so in the month of Ramadan when Gabriel visited him, and Gabriel used to meet him on every night of Ramadan till the end of the month. The Prophet used to recite the Holy Qur'an to Gabriel, and when Gabriel met him, he used to be more generous than a fast wind (which causes rain and welfare). [Sahih Bukhari]

The Messenger of Allah (PBUH) used to supplicate saying, "O Allah! I seek refuge in you from the withholding of your favor, the decline of the good health you have given, the suddenness of your vengeance and from all forms of your wrath." (Bulugh al Maram)

AbdurRahman ibn AbuBakrah said that he told his father: O my father! I hear you supplicating every morning: "O Allah! Grant me health in my body. O Allah! Grant me good hearing. O Allah! Grant me good eyesight. There is no God but Thou." (Sunan Abi Dawud)

The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "The entire earth has been made a place of prayer, except for graveyards and washrooms."
