- Before Care is available from **8:00 AM to 9:00 AM** + After Care is available from **3:30 PM to 4:00 PM**, after **4:00 PM pickups cost \$50 per student.**
- **PLEASE PICK UP YOUR CHILD BETWEEN 3:30-4:00 PM**
- After-care is only available until 5:00 PM for those who NEED it. If you did not register for aftercare, you **must** pick up your child by **4:00PM**. Constant late pickups may be subject to a fee.

- A typical day at camp includes arts and crafts, stories, circle time, qur'an, Islamic studies, recreation, and more, be sure to dress accordingly.
- Provide kids with their own lunches and snacks. We are not liable for any loss of property.
