Assalamualaikum Warahmatullahi Wabarakatuh!

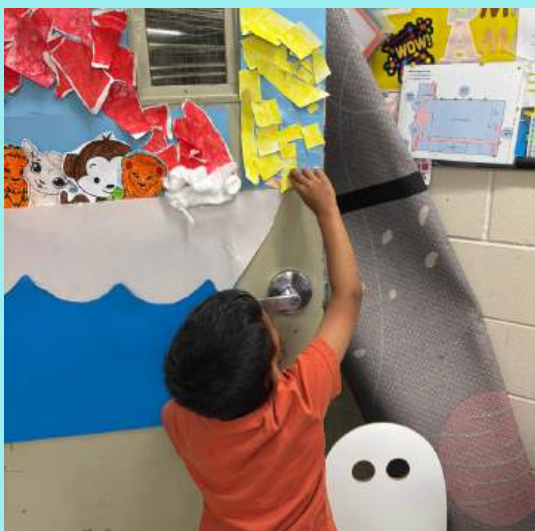
